What is the Purpose of the Endowment Trust?

The purpose of the North Shore Congregational Church Endowment Trust is to provide a vehicle for members and friends to make a lasting endowment of the support and maintenance of the church and for its outreach programs.

To facilitate this purpose, the Trust is divided into two funds:

The **Meetinghouse Fund** is used primarily for extraordinary repairs and improvements to church property.

The **Mission Fund** which is used for extraordinary outreach ministry projects.

Your contributions can be made by specifying the North Shore Congregational Church Endowment Trust. You may then designate the:

- Meetinghouse fund
- Mission Fund
- Percentage given to each of the funds

Who Manages the Trust and How is Distributable Income Determined?

Five Trust Stewards, members of North Shore Congregational Church, who are elected by the congregation, manage the Trust.

The Trust's distributable income is calculated quarterly by applying an appropriate percentage to the market value of the Trust on a cumulative basis. All gifts are intended to be perpetual and only the earnings will be subject to distribution unless otherwise authorized by the members of the Church.

A full report of the Trust's activity is given to the congregation through the Annual Report.

Is the Trust Used for Annual Operations?

The Trust will not be used to generate money for the Church's annual operating expenses. The Trust's charter perpetuates the monies gifted to it and provides that all principal amounts be retained unless otherwise approved by the members of the Church. The Trust is separate from the Church's operating budget and from the annual stewardship giving.
