

Dear Friends,

In our September Midweek Manna gathering, we spent some time exploring the fruits of the spirit as listed in Galatians 5 (love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control). As our discussions continued, some of the conversation surrounded the role we play in attaining/embodying each of these things. In some cases, they seem to be things we need to 'do' in life (self-control, patience, etc.), some are more likely things that we discover (peace, for example), and some are gifted to us as much as we may gift them to others. One of the debates I heard emerge, however, was the question of where joy falls in this mix.

How much of a role do we play in knowing joy in our lives? Is this something that we discover? Something that needs to be imbued upon us by forces beyond ourselves? Is joy simply a gift we know when things are going well and God's blessing abound? Or, perhaps, is there more to it than that?

You will find, in the coming weeks, that our Stewardship Board will be delving into the notion of joy in the context of our giving - the joy that comes from making use of God's blessings in our lives. I will that piece of the puzzle to them. What I found myself drawn to reflect upon after hearing people explore the notion of joy at our Manna gathering, however, was the reminder that there is such a thing as *choosing* joy!

20th century Dutch priest and author, Henri Nouwen, wrote that, "Joy does not simply happen to us. We have to choose joy and keep choosing it every day." He also wrote that, "It is important to become aware that every moment of our life we have an opportunity to choose joy." It is essential, of course, to distinguish between joy and happiness. Not every moment is going to be happy. Not every day is gleeful. Life is filled with its days of challenge, and those darker days won't be filled with a sense of delight. Joy, however, is something deeper. Joy rests in the reminder that the darkness of the moment is not the end of the story. Joy rests in our confidence that hope invades our sorrows. Joy rests in the assurance that God is ours, we are God's, and God's love permeates it all!

The trick, however, is that we have to choose to look there. We have to decide to find joy. We have to be intentional about setting our sights on the promises of God-especially in those moments that are 'less than' we wish they could be. We have a part to play in knowing true joy in our lives. The joy we will know is a wondrous gift from God. To know it, however, we have to choose to look for it, even in (and perhaps especially in) those moments we expect it can't be found!

Following the adorable return of the children telling the story of Christmas last year, we will share the story of Jesus' birth again this December. Be sure to be there on December 14th during the 10am service!






